



# Nordic Handcraft Workshop Materials List

Swedish Kurbits (Dalmålning) Painting with Pieper Bloomquist

*Please note that a \$15 materials fee is payable to the instructor for canvases and other instructor provided supplies. An additional \$10 fee is payable to the instructor if you would like to be provided with paints. ## Students should provide the following items for class:

### Brushes:

- Round Brushes #2, #4, #6. (Good brands are Dick Blick Masterstroke Golden Taklon, Princeton Velvet Touch, Winsor & Newton Cotman)
- Filbert or Round #8 if you have (instructor has a few to borrow)
- Long liner (about ½"-5/8") – for example #3 size Winsor & Newton Cotman Watercolor Brush series 222.
- Short liner #2/0 and #1 Dick Blick Masterstroke Golden Taklon
- Students are encouraged to bring a variety of filbert, round or liner brushes, so bring what you have. We generally will not be using flat brushes.

**Paint:** Instructor uses professional artist acrylics from Winsor & Newton. Golden and Liquitex are also great.

Students may bring their own acrylic paints if they have something close to what is listed below, or they may pay instructor an additional \$10.00 for the use of her paint supply.

- Thalo blue (we will be mixing an indigo blue)
- Raw Sienna or Yellow Ochre
- Burnt Sienna or Red Iron Oxide
- Cadmium Red Light
- Raw Umber
- Burnt Umber
- Sap Green (liquitex)
- Titanium white (any craft paint white is fine)
- Lamp black or Ivory Black (craft paint is fine)

### Household items, etc.

Pencil

Sketch paper

straight edge ruler

scissors

masking or scotch tape

Q-tips (off-brand is best) for clean ups

Wet palette or some type of flat-bottomed container with a Tupperware style lid (7x9 or bigger)

Brush pan (for water)

Palette knife

Paper towel (Viva brand or blue Scott shop towels from Menards are best)
