*Introduction to Acanthus with Jock Holmen
February 12 – March 12, 2025*

February 12-26, Students should provide the following items for class:

The first three weeks of class are drawing only. Please bring tracing paper (e.g. Blick Tracing Paper 11 x 14, item 10609-3005 or similar) and #2 pencils/eraser (e.g. Staedtler Mars plastic eraser/similar), plus a notebook or sketchbook for note taking.

March 5-12, Students should provide the following items for class:

Students should bring whatever carving gouges and chisels they have to the last two sessions of class. A few toolsets are available from the instructor. If you bring your own tools, there will be less time waiting to use the same tool.

Please Note: Do not bring palm tools. If you do not already own the tools before class, wait until the first class to discuss the best options with the instructor before purchasing.

If you have the following tools please bring:

- *Basic tools needed (Tool #s are Pfeil Swiss Made):*
 - *#12 - 12mm V tool*
 - *#1 - 20mm*
 - *#3 - 4mm gouge*
 - *#3 - 20mm gouge*
 - *#5 - 16mm gouge*
 - *#8 - 10mm gouge*
- *Other tools*
 - *#12 - 3mm V tool*
 - *#1s - 20mm beveled 2 sides*
 - *#4 - 14mm gouge*
 - *#6 - 6mm gouge*
 - *#7 - 14mm gouge*
 - *#8 - 14mm gouge*
 - *Mallet*

The book "Acanthus Carving and Design" by Bob Yorburg with illustrations by Hans Sandom is an optional but recommended resource.
